Baseline Indicators	-	No effect of Flood & earth quake. However, some villages, Chandrapura, Dhimarpura, Iqbalpur, adjacent near river Jamani/Betwa may be effected due to flood. It is observed that traffic is obstructed due to heavy rain.
Institutional Structure	-	<p>In Tikamgarh district, disaster management is necessary in the condition of damage due to drought, flood, rain of hailstorms and so on. Tikamgarh has been safe from the natural calamities like earthquake held on 22nd may, 1999 and flood comes in the adjacent rivers and no disaster management felt here in past years but to face with such calamities in future and the damage due to these calamities and to provide rescue in such conditions a Disaster Management Planning Cell and a Control Room has been formed at district and block level. The telephone Nos are described in the plan. In the District, this cell will be directed from Land Record Section of Collectorate having telephone numbers 07683-242242, 242814 & 242042. Control Room will be under observation of Deputy Collector, In-charge Officer (R.A./Rescue Department). Telephone No of Collector office is 07683-242250 and of residence is 07683-242251.</p> <p>Tikamgarh district is surrounded with the rivers like Betwa, Jamuni, Ur, Dhasan and Jamdar which are often prone to flood. Due to heavy rain, the water of Betwa river spread in adjacent villages which brings animal loss and other damages in those areas and the same condition occurs due to Jamni.</p> <p>Tikamgarh district is not known as prone to flood even though in rainy season due to heavy and continue rain Jamni, Betwa and Dhasan become prone to flood. Due to release of large amount of water from Matateela Dam, the adjacent villages come near to the conditions like flood. Apart from this, in other affected villages rescue operations are conducted by Tehsildar of concerned area.</p> <p>In this regard, concerned officers (for their assigned work) are ordered by this action plan :-</p> <p>SDO Niwari and Tehsildar Orchha will make announcement in affected areas after receiving intimation from Chief Engineer Matateela Water Management Board in the condition of releasing large amount of water from the dam. SDO will take all the necessary actions and direct the local officers to keep those areas under observation and immediately inform to district flood and disaster management cell. Necessary actions should be taken to stop water logging and spreading diseases from this in flood affected areas.</p> <p>Natural Disaster Management Cell is established in land record Section of district office and Mr. V.K. Kori (Superintendent Land Record Section, Tikamgarh) will be the nodal officer of this cell. Nodal officer can deploy other officer/worker at their level in the cell. Telephone/Mobile Nos. of officers of affected areas should be displayed upon the wall of the office room. In all the tehsils, a disaster management cell will be formed and their telephone nos. and information of appointed employees must be sent till 15.06.2011. At the sub division and Tehsil level, in-charge of DMC (Disaster Management Cell) will be concerned SDO and Tehsildar. It is necessary to inform immediately to the Disaster Management Cell of district office through Fax, Wireless, Telephone or by a messenger in case of heavy rain, earthquake and flood. In the district, Disaster Management Cell will be permanently established. Disaster Management Cell will work 24x7 hours at the time of heavy rain, earthquake and flood.</p>
